**Functions:** Describe on going actions in the past – Giving extra details

**Grammar:** Past Continuous – Past Simple vs Past Continuous – When and While - Defining relative clauses – Relative Pronouns WHO/WHICH/WHERE/WHOSE

**Vocabulary:** Sports, equipment and facilities
